**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** The motion before you is to elect Senator Bohlke as Chair of the Education Committee by acclamation. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. Congratulations, Senator Bohlke. General Affairs, Chair recognizes Senator Schellpeper.

**SENATOR SCHELLPEPER:** Like to place my name as Chairman of the General Affairs Committee. It's been my privilege to serve as the Chairman for several years. This committee has charge of several issues that are very noncontroversial, like liquor and gambling, and so we, I think, do a very good job with those two issues. I look forward to serving as the Chairman for the next two years. Thank you.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Are there any further nominations? Seeing none, Senator Coordsen.

**SENATOR COORDSEN:** Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I move that nominations cease and that Senator Stanley Schellpeper be declared, by acclamation, the Chair of General Affairs Committee.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** The motion before you is the motion to elect Senator Schellpeper by acclamation. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. Congratulations, Senator Schellpeper. You are the new Chair of General Affairs. Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, Senator Janssen.

**SENATOR JANSSEN:** Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I'd like to place my name in contention for the nomination of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Seven years ago I was given the opportunity to serve on the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. By a strange coincidence, I was placed, by my selection committee, to be on the Judiciary Committee, but someone wanted to trade and I said, well, that's...I asked Senator Coordsen, I said, is that the way it works around here? And he said, well, sure, you can, you can do that. So I did and it was my...it was my pleasure to have served on that committee since I've been here and the last four years as Vice Chair of the committee. Last
