PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: (Recorder not activated immediately) ...morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifth day of the session. Our prayer today is arranged by Senator Hudkins' office and our chaplain is Elder Nead of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.
