you're understanding that you, as members of the Legislature, are ceding part of the process to one individual who's saying we either do this or you're going to lose part of your process, which is the consent calendar. And he's proud of it, and we all know that, but it is about us. You may not even know which side of it you're on, but you will know in the process that we are not doing the best job that we could because we don't have a way to get to those amendments that actually allow us to improve our legislation.
