PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CROSBY: It's a Catch-22. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Chair recognizes Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I really rise to...well, I didn't want to, but somebody's got to do Senator Crosby's work for her. She's not going to tell you to vote against this, but I am. I'm going to vote against it. I'm going to vote against anything that takes money, and we have to pay money to a volunteer. This...these people that are getting \$8,000 a year, room and board, benefits, all the rest. Are they volunteers? No, they're people working for a wage. A volunteer is someone who comes along and says, this needs to be done and I'll help do it or I'll do it. That's a volunteer. There are a lot of volunteers where I come from. I sure...I'm sure that there's a lot of volunteers where all of us come from. That's what a lot of the organizations that you see--Elks, Lions, Moose, Eagle, the whole menagerie. But what these people do, and I'm not making fun of them because a lot of them do an enormous amount of good and they do it on their time and a lot of times with their money and they ask for no reward other than the fact that they're making their community a little bit better. This is a way to start off at seventy-some thousand, \$72,000, and what Senator Crosby says is absolutely right--it will grow. The number of people on salary will grow. It is a natural tendency to build little empires. Here we don't have an empire. This is just a small colony, but some day it can be an empire. This is feel-good legislation, but it doesn't really do anything except take public money, and here again I just...I can only repeat what Senator Crosby said, it will grow and it is the kind of money that we promised the people who we asked to vote for us that we would not spend. I'm going to vote against this if nobody else does, and I ask you to really give it some thought. This thing has existed by executive order for
