SENATOR COORDSEN: Time.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Chairman or Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the committee amendment mainly involves a change in the...a change in the extension of the Leaky Underground Storage Tank Program. I believe Senator Bromm's original bill extended the program for five years, and the committee amendment extends it two years.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Beutler, your light is on. Did you wish to speak to the committee amendments or the bill?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, I do not.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bromm, to speak to the committee amendment. Senator Bromm waives off. There are no other lights on, Senator Schrock. Did you wish to close on the committee amendment? Thank you. Closing is waived. The issue before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 270. Those in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Committee amendments are adopted. The issue before the body is the advancement of LB 270. Senator Beutler.
