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these people are the same political party or not. Sometimes you can have personality conflicts and, you know, you could have the Treasurer and DAS not getting along, it could be turf war, it could be anything. So I raised that at the committee hearing, that I do have some concerns with that. I think you ought to think about that particular part of the bill, too. It's usually better to have one person in charge, and then that person bears the responsibility for the decisions that are made. But it didn't seem to be a huge issue but one that I think that we should think about. So with that, I would just encourage you to adopt the committee amendment which then does become the bill. And, Senator Cudaback, would you care for any more of my time? If I could yield my time to Senator Cudaback, please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes, and I agree with everything that Senator Schimek has said here, and this bill is for you and for us. It's not for, you know, any one individual. It is supposed to make things better, not worse, and so any suggestions you might have, why we'll work them out, naturally, and if it doesn't work, why we can always do away with the program. Nothing says we have to have it. It's a program that's supposed to save us dollars and be more efficient and, hopefully, it will. And there are subdivisions currently doing this, and so maybe this will help some of them out, clear up what they're doing, not to hinder what they're doing, but to clear up and make them...the authorization allows them to. I think that there might be some question in some instances, but there are counties that do this now. So if they're going to do it, they should...it should be in the statute that they can do it, I think you'll all agree. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 113. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Mr. President, I think maybe I'm going to have to ask for a call of the house, roll call vote.
