SENATOR LANDIS: Committee amendment I think was to move from three to seven days the amount of notice for when somebody's late with their renewal. I'm sorry, let me make the motion to accept the committee amendment. They are an amendment to Section 1 of the bill. If an insurance company fails to file its annual statement when due the notice shall be given in seven days rather than three days. We're finding it's tough to meet the three-day standard, so we're going to give the department seven days to give the notices out. That's the committee amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Landis. Any discussion on the committee amendment? Senator Matzke, your light is on. Did you want to talk about the committee amendment? Senator Matzke. Senator Matzke, your light is on. Did you want to talk about the committee amendments?
