SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Any dis...oh, you may open now on committee amendments. (Standing Committee amendment AM0051 is found on page 349 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay. The committee amendment is a very simple one. The judgment of the committee was why should we go through this list? Why should we be listing cities, villages, school districts, NRDs, counties, et cetera? So the committee amendment is a simple one. Simply strike educational service units from the green copy and insert the words "all other taxing units", so that it won't make any difference and we won't have to keep going through the list and adding on someone else that is entitled to a semimonthly distribution from the treasurer's office. We think it is possible for the treasurers to do that. While there had been objections previously to these kinds of distributions, there didn't seem to be any objections this year and we hope you agree with the committee amendment so we don't have to keep going through our list.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Any discussion on the committee amendments to 287? Seeing none, you may...Senator Wickersham waives closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 287. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The committee amendments are adopted. Discussion on LB 287? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham waives closing on LB 287. The question is the advancement of LB 287 to E & R. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 287.

SENATOR CROSBY: LB 287 advances. LB 19.

CLERK: LB 19, by Senator Landis. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 7, referred to the Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill,
