SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the opening. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Judiciary Committee offers committee amendments, Mr. President. (See Standing Committee amendment, AM0029, on page 350 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on the Judiciary Committee amendments.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, we have made a simple change to the bill as originally presented by the amendment, and we are eliminating some phraseology that is not consistent with the Nebraska statutes, and in fact was inadvertently taken that originates with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. And I would urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the committee amendments? Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on committee amendments. He waives the closing on the committee amendments. The question before the body is the adoption of the Judiciary Committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Committee amendments are adopted. Debate on advancement of LB 48? Senator Brashear, seeing no debate, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 48 to E & R Initial.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, thank you. Members of the body, I'd urge the advancement of the bill as amended. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 48 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 48.
