The only other part of the amendment is that it provi...we added language providing that the implementation of this would be processed according to the rules and regs of the Department of Motor Vehicles, which the Department of Motor Vehicles requested that language, and no one had any problem with that amendment. So we would ask the body to adopt this amendment. And while I'm speaking, in case there isn't much discussion, I think this is a...this is a...a positive step towards trying to further take some of...some of the complications that we all experience in registering vehicles, reducing some of those complications, at least for specific situations. This applies, as Senator Peterson said, only to the apportioned vehicles, the fleet vehicles. So we...we...the committee supported the bill and would like to see the body advance it and we ask that you adopt this amendment first, however. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the committee amendment? Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, this may be on the main bill, but I'll talk...ask questions on the...so I have to clarify, Senator Peterson. Fleet would not include farm plates, is that right?

SENATOR C. PETERSON: No.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: They would not...

SENATOR C. PETERSON: This is for the...the...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Fleet.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: ...fleet appropriation, that they are done under 60-305.9.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. And if...does that include pickups? Is that called a truck under this?

SENATOR C. PETERSON: No, it does not include pickups; they are not called a truck. This is for the tractor and the tractor-trailer, which is the front part.
