SENATOR C. PETERSON: Um-huh.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: All right, thank you. That answers my questions.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the committee amendments? Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on committee amendments. He waives the closing on the committee amendments. The question before the body is the adoption of the Transportation Committee amendments to LB 291. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The committee amendments are adopted. We're back to debating the advancement of LB 291. Senator Peterson, you're recognized to close. She waives closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 291 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 291.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (LB) 291 advances. LB 259.

CLERK: (LB) 259, Mr. President, by Senator Landis. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 11 of this year, referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on 259.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Kristensen, members of the Legislature. This bill was brought on behalf of the Department of Insurance, it was supported by the Nebraska Land Title Association, and reported out seven-zip by the committee.
