PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the eighteenth day of the Nebraska Unicameral. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor Frank Zimmerman of the First Christian Church of Auburn, Senator Vrtiska's district. Pastor.

PASTOR ZIMMERMAN: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Pastor. We will call to order the session. Will senators please check in. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, on page 393, insert corrections to the lobby report. That's the only correction I have this morning.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you. Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports (LB) 140A, (LB) 258, (LB) 260, (LB) 326, (LB) 287, LB 19, (LB) 23, (LB) 24, (LB) 102, (LB) 228, (LB) 48, and (LB) 72 to Select File, some of those having Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Hearing notice from the Urban Affairs Committee, several hearing notices from Banking, Commerce and Insurance, and two different notices from Business and Labor. Mr. President, Senator Schellpeper has selected LB 126 as his priority bill for this session. That's all that I have at this time. (See pages 402-404 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will move to General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 195, a bill introduced by Senator Suttle. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 8 of this year. At that time, it was referred to the Education Committee. Bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
