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SENATOR C. PETERSON: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Is this? Is this that same issue?

SENATOR C. PETERSON: No, this...I do not believe it is, Senator Wehrbein. I believe this is...that was with the PEAP funds. This would not be.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: But I will get back and check for sure on you with that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I do need to understand a lot more about this before I am willing to vote on this and that's what all I have to say.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I know, Senator Peterson, would you answer a couple questions for me?
