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said that it had to be approximately, I think, ten days before the meeting, and obviously "approximately" is an ambiguous term. We're changing that so that it's explicitly five days prior to the meeting. There is one further small amendment to the committee amendments and I would discuss that briefly and then maybe we can move on to substance.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wickersham would move to amend the committee amendment. (FA5 is found on page 410 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: With the body's indulgence, within the committee amendment, on page 12, on line 21, there's a phrase that says, "A county agricultural society may, by resolution, request the county board to place the question of reformation of the society before the registered voters of the county." To may..to be that absolutely clear, I'm asking that the word "board" be inserted after the word "society", so it's a county agricultural society board may, by resolution, request reformation. And that addresses another issue in the bill and that is, how do you change from an agricultural society to a county fair board, or from a county fair board to an agricultural society? That process is set out and, in all cases, there is a resolution of the board and then, potentially, it always holds a potential for being submitted to the voters for adoption. But there is a process for moving between the different kinds of structures so that you can make an election in your county as to the one that fits your needs and carries out the county fair functions, which I believe are important in our communities.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Lights were turned on, on the bill, so I am going to clear the board. Those that would like to speak on the amendment to the amendment then can turn their lights back on. Chair recognizes Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, thank you, Mr. Chairman and members.
