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SENATOR WICKERSHAM: It's identical levy restrictions.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. I...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: It's just that you clearly would have a political subdivision as opposed to a private nonprofit.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Because it's stated in law.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Beutler, would you like to speak on the amendment to the amendments?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. Senator Wickersham, just a clarification or two, somewhat along the lines of Senator Wehrbein. Let's go through the process of exceeding the levy limitation as that concept would apply to the three types of organizations. Can you take us...can you take us through that?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: If...if we wanted to exceed the levy limitation, what is the process in each case?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: For an agricultural society or an elected fair board, if this bill passes, it would be a town hall meeting.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so that...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: For the...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that would...that would just be a vote of all of the residents of the county...
