SENATOR WICKERSHAM: You have...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...who showed up at the meeting. Is that right?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: You have to, in order to have a quorum, you need to have at least 10 percent present.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Ten percent of?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The registered voters, in this case, in the county. So 10 percent of the registered voters in the county would have to attend a meeting called for the specific purpose of deciding whether or not to override the levy limitations.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that's whether you're talking about an agricultural society or about...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Or an...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...an elected board.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Or an elected board. In the case of an appointed board...

SENATOR BEUTLER: So if 10 percent shows up then it's a majority of those showing up to exceed the levy limit?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's the same structure that's in place for other miscellaneous subdivisions:...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...a cemetery district, a fire district,
