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those who deal with other peoples' property and other peoples' lives without being held accountable to anybody. So, Senator Bromm, I'm going to ask that you consider this idea, because later on in the proceedings I may offer it as an amendment. Now, to go back to what is before us, namely Senator Tyson's amendment,...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...I'm not going to say that Senator Tyson's motives are not sincere. The nature of his amendment answers that question, if it's a question in anybody's mind. But you must understand that the subjects share very little with the ruler, other than the territory in which they both find themselves. The lord of the manner shares very little with the serf, other than the fact that they may occupy the same ground. But I'm sure everybody knows that the rights and privileges of the respective individuals are entirely different. So I hope the body will not, in the cavalier manner that this amendment is offered, adopt it. It is not a good amendment,...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Well first of all, Senator Chambers, I would like to volunteer to be your agent. I think I can get you a commercial on next year's Super Bowl for your Honda. If you can't, it would be a lot better than a lot of commercials that I saw. I think we got something there; 400 and some thousand miles, and not always probably driven at the slowest speeds in the world either, I'll bet. (Laughter.) In any event, I want to point out a couple of things with response...in response to Senator Tyson's amendment. First of all, had we seen Senator Tyson's bill early enough in the referencing process, we would have scheduled it for hearing at the same time or same day as LB 90. But LB 90 was in early, it had had a considerable amount of work done, we thought it was a bill we could get up and out fairly quickly, and we did. So I...for that I am sorry; it was a matter of timing, Senator Tyson, otherwise I can assure you we would like to have had your bill simultaneous with Senator Cudaback's. That having occurred, here we are at this point. And I guess I want the body to understand that the significance of the amendment, as
