best I can, and so I'm going to look at the language just a little bit. The amendment only changes the \$250, in Section 2 of the committee amendment, to \$500. But read that language in its entirety. It does say, if an abandoned vehicle, at the time of abandonment, has no license plates of the current year affixed, and is of a wholesale value, a wholesale value, taking into consideration the condition of the vehicle, \$250 or less. So that would be changed to \$500 or less. There is a difference, to some extent, between retail value, there always is when I buy a car, anyway, or when I sell one. I buy at retail, and I sell always at wholesale. And so, if you're thinking that that necessarily is what you would buy a car from a dealer for, that 250, or 500, I'd suggest that this is the vehicle the dealer...this is the amount the dealer would pay you if you went in to try to trade your car in, or to sell it to him. So I wanted to point that out. We did have considerable discussion last year about this level of amount, and there was support for the 250. Frankly, I don't know that we ran the \$500 up the flag pole very much. So I guess I leave it to the body to speak on this issue. Senator Tyson has every right to offer his amendment. I do have concerns that, if there is a lot of opposition and the amendment is narrowly adopted, this bill is an important bill for passage, and I don't want to see the bill drowned in a pool of controversy that isn't worth it, frankly, for the question involved. So I'll yield the rest of my time to you, Mr. Speaker. Thank you.
