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bill, and would urge the adoption of the committee amendment and the advancement of Senator Chambers' bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brashear. The Chair recognizes Senator Tyson for discussion on the committee amendments.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I am looking at the...what Senator Chambers regards as the "gizmo" and the green copy of the bill. And I would ask Senator Chambers, in re...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR TYSON: ...in regards Section 2 of your bill,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR TYSON: ...why isn't "every person", in other words, another inmate also included in this?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Because this is a different kind of an offense. If an inmate does something to another inmate, there are laws that cover that already in addition to disciplinary rules in case the contact or, whatever it is, activity does not rise to the level of what we're talking about in this bill. We're trying to protect inmates and parolees from those who have supervisory control or custodial control over them. That's the purpose of this bill.

SENATOR TYSON: So other people are already covered is what you're saying?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay, thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no additional lights, Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on committee amendment AM0132.
