SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Seeing no further lights on debate of the committee amendments, Senator Landis, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR LANDIS: The committee amendments is the retention of the \$15 fee on the application for an ATM. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 396. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Committee amendments are adopted. We next move to debate on the advancement 396. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Landis, a question, just on one section, if I may.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I'll do my best.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And it's Section 9 of the bill that has to do with the ATMs.

SENATOR LANDIS: What page are you on, Chris?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'm on page 18, it actually begins on 17.

SENATOR LANDIS: All right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But my question has to do with the striking of the old language and the new language on page 18. And I'm asking this because I don't understand fully the parameters of banking activity insofar as the types of things that they can do. And so I wanted a clarification in that regard. With regard to the use of the ATM, the old language seemed to indicate that the director could approve such other kinds of transactions as he chose to approve. I assume that a natural
