their own special form, and then interlocal agreements relating to agricultural societies will have another set of statutes, and so forth and so forth? I was wondering if you could just talk generally about where you think we're going in this area, because I'm beginning to grow concerned about what it means in terms of complexity, simplicity versus increased ability to cooperate?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Beutler and members of the body, I...you know, I had that...what it...I think what I'm try...I'm attempting to do...this was brought to me by the library, you know, commissioners. And I think it simply sets up a different structure that will encourage library use across the st...allow some type of structure. The question of the interlocal, this is...you know, maybe it's a duplication, but I think it provides, you know, to library directors and city councils and counties more of a structure of how you could do this process. And that's why...that is why, I guess, I'm introducing it. And, you know, this adds another layer, you know, kind of a way that they can do it. And I, you know, can see your concern, because, you know, is this, you know, is...I see this...the reason I did this, and I did raise that question myself in my own mind, what you're doing, Senator Beutler. But I see this as I think...
