SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hartnett, your light is on.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I think Senator Beutler raised some good points. I think, Senator Beutler, if it would be all right if we...if this bill advances, maybe sit down with you and the library people and see...you know, get their rationale on this issue, because I think you raised some very good questions. I'd simply ask the amendment be adopted is all. I think we're talking about the amendment, so....

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'll waive on the amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the Hartnett amendment? Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close on your amendment. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Hartnett amendment to LB 362. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I think Senator Beutler has his light on, so I'll let him....
