PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bromm, is there anything in 161 now, with the adoption of the committee amendment, other than the date changes?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR COORDSEN: And that is?

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. The...the exemptions that are stricken on page 3 in the committee bill, where it says, "shall not apply to", it says, "farm trucks registered pursuant to 6330", then it goes on to say, "with a gross weight of 60 tons" and so forth, on that page, on line 12 we are...we are reinstating the stricken matter beginning with "with a gross weight of 16 tons or less", we're reinstating that language. And in line 15, in line 15, after the first...let's see, after the first stricken "and", we are inserting the stricken matter beginning with "fertilizer and agricultural chemical equipment". And then we're adding language as follows: "if the equipment is not required to be placarded, pursuant to Section 75-364". So that section is different than changing dates. And on page 6, line 23, we are reinstating the stricken matter, because that was an inadvertent strike in the drafting of the bill.
