SENATOR BROMM: That's true, in general, Senator Jones. LB 161 does not change the situations where a CDL license will be required, or where it is not required. It does not affect that with the amendments that we're proposing.

SENATOR JONES: Thank you. I just wanted to get that clear on everybody's mind, because if you wanted to go in and pull your own out, you won't have to have a CDL license. And I think since you brought it up about the CDL license, I thought I should try to clear that up. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Jones. Seeing no further discussion, Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 161.

SENATOR BROMM: I'll waive closing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm waives closing. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 161 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 161.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 161 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?
