Kearney, represented by 25 youth, and 25 adult, in the north balcony. Would you please rise and be recognized by the Legislature. Thank you for joining us this morning. For discussion on the Wickersham amendment, Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, Mr. Wizard, despite your very commendable efforts, you're not going to draw me into a discussion of this bill this morning. (Laugh.) I just want to let you know that. (Laughter.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I think the stars are in alignment. Please support the amendment. (Laughter.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the adoption of AM0273 to LB 437. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Wickersham amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Smith.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move we adopt the E & R amendments...is that in order?

CLERK: Advance the bill, Senator.

SENATOR SMITH: I move we advance LB 437 to E & R for grossment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion is the advancement of LB 437 to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.
