PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no further discussion, Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR BROMM: I would waive closing, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the adoption of AM0288 to LB 90. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Smith.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Cudaback, did you want to be recognized? No, okay. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move for the advancement of LB 90 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion is the advancement of LB 90. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. LB 90 is advanced.
