SENATOR BOHLKE: ...I listened to your...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...to your concerns. They seem to be with Section 2, mainly. The other, and that's where I have my concerns, but I also recognize, I think, the need, the seriousness of the bill and how important it is, the other three sections. If we, as Senator Bromm said he was willing to do, I would hope that we could maybe advance it if Section 2 were pulled out, and would that meet your concerns as well?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That would meet my concerns as far as just trying to wipe out the bill, but there's still some other questions I would have about the bill that I haven't been able to get to because of this.

SENATOR BOHLKE: All right, then I stand in opposition to the bracket hoping that Senator Bromm and Senator Chambers could work something out. I know on the agenda at eleven-thirty we move to something else.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR BOHLKE: I would hope that we could address this particular amendment, remove the section from the bill and advance it to Select File.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The Chair recognizes Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you very much, Mr. President. I wonder if Senator Chambers would yield to a question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: See what Senator Bohlke started. Yes, I will yield, Senator Bromm.
