SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I have known Mr. Carlson for a lot less time than Senator Matzke, 15 years I suppose, but the reason I rise is to give him, Mr. Carlson, a sterling endorsement, that my wife says his wife is really nice, and that is good enough for me.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no further lights, Senator Dierks, you're recognized to close on the confirmation report.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, or, Mr. President. I just want to urge your vote of approval for Mr. Carlson. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the adoption of the confirmation report of the Agriculture Committee. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who intend to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The confirmation report is adopted. Before we proceed, Senator Byars would like to announce the following guests are visiting the Legislature, Kathie Reichstein from Beatrice and Mildred Conkling from Lincoln. They are located under the north balcony. Welcome. Members, please join me in welcoming them. We will now proceed to Final Reading. Will members please take their seats, and unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Mr. Clerk, LB 83.

CLERK: (Read LB 83 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 546 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.
