Schmitt. He wanted you to all know that he celebrated is 35th wedding anniversary this Sunday. Senator Schmitt, thank you very much. We next move to General File. Mr. Clerk, LB 148A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 148A by Senator Byars. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Byars, you're recognized to open on the A bill.

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. I think this body sent a message when we...when we had the discussion on LB 148 relative to the need and the priority we needed to set for any type of legislation that had substantial accompanying fiscals. I think it was quite clear through the debate, the unanimous advancement of this bill by the committee, the strong endorsement by the committee members and members of this body and, without belaboring the point, I would move LB 148A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Discussion on advancement of the bill? Seeing none, Senator Byars, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 148A to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 148A.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (LB) 148A advances. LB 465.

CLERK: (LB) 465, Mr. President, a bill by Senator Wehrbein. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 14, referred to the Appropriations Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on LB 465.
