SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, I think in the report I handed out to you, Senator Wehrbein, that I think it's been estimated by the Exec Committee about 15...15 cities have applied for tax increment financing. So that's kind of where the numbers...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: At 1,500 to 2,000 each for their expenses to do the analysis.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I wanted to be clear of that. So it's subject to annual appropriation, depending on the need within the fund,...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...because there's no apparent revenue source.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'm kind of reiterating what is in the A bill and the fiscal note, not a note...A bill, the fiscal note.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And I just wanted to clarify that that would be the intent of you as far as the way this was to be funded and the way it was to be used.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, we estimate about 30,000 a year, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, thank you.
