SENATOR BOHLKE: It clarifies the community college boundaries.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Bohlke, there are no further lights. Do you wish to close on the committee amendments? Senator Bohlke waives closing on the committee amendments. The vote will be on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 596. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advance...or adoption of committee amendments. Excuse me.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The committee amendments are adopted. Any discussion on the advancement of LB 596? There are no lights. Senator Bohlke, you are recognized to close on the advancement of LB 596. Senator Bohlke waives closing. The vote is on the advancement of LB 596 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 596.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: LB 596 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, the only items at this time, a series of adds: Senator Redfield to (LB) 299; Crosby to (LB) 653; Robak, (LB) 653; Dwite Pedersen, (LB) 653; Senator Cudaback to (LB) 314. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (See pages 603-604 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Smith, would you like to make a motion?

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. I would move we adjourn until Thursday, February 18th, at 9:00 a.m.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: All in favor? That's enough ayes for me. The motion is adopted.
