SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is the sister of Senator Matt Connealy. She is Sister Joy Connealy from the Sisters of Notre Dame in Omaha. She's a constituent of Senator Lynch. Sister.
