ASSISTANT CLERK: 39 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to dispense with reading, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 260 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 636 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 260 passes. LB 278E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 278E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 278 with the emergency clause pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 636-637 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 278 with the emergency clause passes. LB 287.
