CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill is returned. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers offers an amendment found on page 493, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your specific amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I would move for the adoption of the amendment that I explained, and, again, if you have any questions, I will answer them at this time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the Chambers amendment. Seeing none, Senator Chambers waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LB 72. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Chambers amendment is adopted. Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Chairman, I move that we advance LB 72E to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion to readvance LB 72E. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is readvanced. We will next move to Select File, LB 396. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Smith, with respect to LB 396, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to adopt the amendments.
