CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bohlke, I now have AM0347 in front of me, Senator. (See page 649 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to open on the amendment.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. This amendment was brought to us by the Class I schools and what it does is clarifies that the request for Class I districts to exceed their budget authority is for the total general fund budget of the expenditures. This is in response to their concerns that they had heard from some of their Class I districts.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to close on your amendment. She waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of AM0347 to LB 813. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Members, if you care to vote, would you please do so? Record.
