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would not accept the fact that there's a need for this kind of a commission to deal with this issue that's so important to many of our young people in this state and certainly those who are involved in this issue. So I just wanted to go on record as a strong supporter of Senator Crosby's bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I need to ask Senator Crosby a question or two, if she would respond.

SENATOR CROSBY: All right.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Crosby, I noticed that there is some...some money that would have to be appropriated some time and...for this. Is that...

SENATOR CROSBY: Right. We are...we're working on an A bill right now, because...

SENATOR COORDSEN: And...

SENATOR CROSBY: ...we didn't have all the numbers that we needed for an A bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: And that money would, what, then be appropriated as part of the...as the Legislative Council's budget, and then the Exec Board would make the determination of how...

SENATOR CROSBY: That's right. That's right. That's right.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Um-hum.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the bill? Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mister...thank you, Mr. Speaker, and, Senator Crosby, I kind of apologize for not having had an opportunity to really review the bill, but I've quickly reviewed
