my only plea is that if we're going to do this, take a look at the big picture and don't begin to piecemeal this, because it's going to lead to disparate results. I really think that the way the bill's drafted is that you could have two people and two different entities, one self-employed, one in a...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...a limited liability company, for example, who wouldn't technically be self-employed. One's going to add back depreciation; the other isn't. And we're going to come back and wind up fixing that because it isn't fair. The bottom line for me becomes you could invest in a piece of property and buy a building and depreciate it over 30 years and, as I read that, you're going to get to take that off and not...not have that count at all towards the calculation of child support. The bottom line is, what's more important? You've got that extra...you've got that money. It's not extra, but you've got that money and for the next 29 years after the year you buy it, you're not expending any money for it but you're getting a tax deduction for it, so you've got more actual dollars in your pocket. What's more important? Do you spend that money to support your children, or do you plow that money back in? And I...I'm going to come down on the other side. I just don't think that that's a...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...a legitimate basis for doing it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Before we proceed, I'd like to announce that Senator Cudaback has a guest visiting the Legislature this morning. He is Ernie French of Lexington. He's under the south balcony.
