SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

CLERK: That's what I have in front of me, Senator. (See AM0313 on page 569 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on the amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: This is the amendment that falls in line with what we just passed. And I intended to go...this should take it at 900,000. I may have misspoke. Actually, these are 350,000, which is 550,000 previously, which makes it 350, going to 900,000, which is the cap that I intended per the previous (LB) 243. I probably said 600,000, it's 550,000 presently in there. This would take it now to 900,000, as I correctly stated. The A bill then...this adds 350,000 each year.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment to 243A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein, I now have (AM)0317.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Withdraw that, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: AM0315.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I want to withdraw that one.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
