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this would not expand or allow for expansion of current authority and policy, but would provide some exceptions in those areas where people actually reside. Senator Bohike raised the question of Mahoney Park and the designation at the cabins. There was some confusion, perhaps, over what the actual policy is. My staff just contacted Game and Parks, and they said that currently at Mahoney State Park there are 24 nonsmoking lodge cabins, and there are 16 where smoking is allowed in those cabins, in the lodge. In the actual cabins there is no designation, and so someone can either smoke or not smoke, it's up to the person who rents the cabin. So where Senator Bohike would like to have some cabins restricted so there is no smoking in those and smoking in some others, so she or others, who don't want to rent a cabin where somebody has been smoking, and it's still remaining in the cabin, is currently being done. So that's a current Game and Parks policy. They do restrict 24 of the rooms in the lodge, but they don't have a designation or a set policy on any of the actual out-cabins, that are away from the lodge. So, that issue would still be left to Game and Parks, they would still have the option, they would still have the ability to designate what they did in those cabins, as with the actual lodges where they do have a current policy. This, I think, addresses rather clearly and specifically the issue of whether or not you can restrict the smoking where somebody is actually a veteran and having real difficulties, particularly when the Department of the Armed...of Military...Military Department and the Armed Forces had actually, at one time, provided cigarettes in C rations, I think they were called C rations at that time. So, I would certainly welcome any questions. I think the amendment is fairly easy to understand; it is on your desk. I don't know that it's on our laptops at this point. I think there are some people checking. This possibly could be, and I would be open to an amendment. I'm not sure exactly how to draft into this the exclusion for the State Fair Park, without doing it to the entire State Fair Park, but allowing for the exception in those areas where there is, I believe it would be the simulcast area. And, with that exception, I know of no others, or no others that have been brought to my attention for any other exclusions, other than the ones that we have listed already. With that, I will conclude my opening, and thank you very much for listening.
