SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. Once again, I have to rise in opposition to the Preister amendment. Any time this body tried to do something, as is proposed in the Preister amendment, we get into big problems. We found out, we always find out that we're either going too far, or else not far enough. Whenever you start to list something, I think the Peterson was a good idea because it left the governing body decide what they wanted to do with their own buildings. But this is a major, major proposal this morning that hasn't had a hearing. The original bill came in and said it's the State Fair...it's the State Capitol Building. I think that's a good idea, once again. But here I think the body is getting into something that we shouldn't be getting into this morning. It's not something that we know that everything is going to be covered, and it isn't. We don't need every building at the State Fair Park to be smoke-free, but we just...we also need to have some out there where they can smoke because the simulcasting has got two different buildings, they have two different beer gardens in the buildings, so there's no way that you could list those out; they'd have to be listed separately. You're always going to find, I think, some other state entities are going to be the same way. So I would urge the body not to accept the Preister amendment this morning. Let's go ahead with the bill in the original form. It's a good bill; it's a very clean bill. It does what Senator Schmitt wants to do, and I'd urge the body not to support the Preister amendment because it's something that will not be easy to enforce, and I think it will be almost impossible to enforce, especially on the buildings at the State Fair Park. Thank you.
