SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the Dierks amendment? Seeing none, Senator Dierks, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Dierks amendment to 379. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Dierks' amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move we advance LB 379 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 379 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. LB 17.

CLERK: LB 17, I do have E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 17.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.
