SENATOR TYSON: No, that would not happen. As a matter of fact, Senator, you, in a lot of areas, you would not even confine your search to the United States. You might go global.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 67.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on 67, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move we advance LB 67 to E & R for engrossing.
