**PRESIDENT MAURSTAD:** Thank you, Senator. Motion is to put the house under call. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** 25 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

**PRESIDENT MAURSTAD:** The house is under call. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor and would senators please check in. At this time, I would like to announce that Senator Byars has the following guests visiting the Legislature: Mitch, Colleen, Jessica, and Ben Deines, and Tanna Kimmerling from Beatrice, under the south balcony. If you would join me in welcoming them to the Nebraska Legislature. Senators Brashear, Bromm, Bruning, Senator Coordsen, Hudkins, Senator Janssen, Senator Thompson, Senator Schmitt, Senator Schrock, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Quandahl, Senator Matzke, the house is under call. Please record your presence. Senators Brashear and Schrock, the house is under call. The motion before us is the Chambers amendment to LB 356. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Senator Byars has requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** (Roll call vote taken. See pages 704-705 of the Legislative Journal.) Vote is 22 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

**PRESIDENT MAURSTAD:** The Chambers amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, I have a priority motion. Senator Chambers would move to reconsider the vote just taken.

**PRESIDENT MAURSTAD:** The call is raised. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your motion to reconsider.
