Tyson's amendment. So I apologize. Misinterpreted...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: You're recognized to open on that amendment, Senator.

SENATOR LYNCH: On...on 491? On the other...on the amendment to Tyson's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: On the amendment to the bill, sir.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members, 491 is the amendment that takes out, strikes from the bill, language regarding nonmember employees who are members of an organization, then I'm have to admit I'm a little confused because that is not the bill. That is language that's contained, if I'm correct, in the Tyson amendment, and that's what I wanted to amend. And I did ask to withdraw this amendment before and then we brought it back up again, but was I right or wrong?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Okay, we'll...

SENATOR LYNCH: You said Amendment 491 and I said I withdraw it? I thought I said that earlier.

CLERK: Senator, I...

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes.

CLERK: ...I'm interpreting the amendment that you want to withdraw as the amendment to the Tyson amendment, that we're not on. That was the handwritten amendment you had given me. What I have in front of me is AM0491. It starts out on page 2, line 23.

SENATOR LYNCH: Withdraw.

CLERK: Withdraw?

SENATOR LYNCH: Withdraw.

CLERK: Thank you.
