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and I guess, simply put, it's my understanding from some legal people, bargaining unit oriented or not, say that got to talk to your senators and congressmen in Washington to get that done, because that's part of the law. And, in fact, some time ago, maybe some of you remember, I'm old enough to remember, Taft-Hartley Federal Act, Section 14(b) allowed the states to enact right-to-work laws, and that's what we did. And so, if you wanted to change the law to provide what you suggested, Senator Redfield, we'd have to get a federal change to do that, and that's fine. You know, we can...we can go after that, but, again, that would have nothing to do with anything except how you feel that "nonbargaining" unit employees shouldn't have to pay and they should be willing to...they should be willing, I guess, not to have to join and, of course, that's a moot question, because they don't have to join anything either. I...I (laugh) I know that in your minds there are still some other questions and concern you have and maybe some of you don't want to talk about it. I...I'm not sure why Senator Tyson withdrew...did you withdraw your amendment, Senator Tyson?

SENATOR TYSON: Yes, I did.

SENATOR LYNCH: Oh, okay. Because I was going to read the parts of the amendments that I thought were fantastic and I thought, being a good conservative like Senator Tyson is, that he would want to see these same kind of principles involved with every A bill and that's the reason I suggested we support it and I think because I suggested we support it he withdrew it, because I think he was trying to point out, aha, we'll get you guys that are out there bargaining for everybody because we're going to put you through hoops that's going to make it impossible for you to be able to do what I don't want you to do. I guess that's the best way to put it. And then I said, hey, it's a good idea. He said, no, we got to withdraw, we got to withdraw. I'd just think about that. You see, I had another amendment that went up, in case he withdrew it, that I would reinstate it to make sure, you know, if we got to the amendment, that we had that language in there. Simply put, ladies and gentlemen, we could probably go back and forth for some time regarding this bill. Somebody once said, was it Franklin D. Roosevelt, that you have nothing to fear but fear itself. Well, some of the people that have been...
