SENATOR LYNCH: Yeah, Mr. Speaker and members, I...it's late in the morning and I would like to have a call of the house before the vote, but I don't want to have a call of the house just so they can hear what I have to say. So what I'd like to do is ask for a call of the house and I'll just keep on talking and we'll know when it's time to call the vote. Would that be all right?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Lynch, as long as you understand that...

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...your time on closing will count against...or the time that people have to get here counts against your closing time.

SENATOR LYNCH: Fine.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay. There's been a request to place the house under call. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.
