SENATOR THOMPSON: Mr. President, members of the body, this concept was brought to me by a number of people interested in domestic violence issues. We introduced the bill, but there are a number of problems with it and I prefer to withdraw the bill and come back with a better bill next session.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Is there discussion on the motion to withdraw LB 724? Senator Thompson, you're recognized to close. Senator Thompson waives closing. The motion before us is the motion to withdraw LB 724. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
