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returning it to Select File for the...of striking the enacting clause. Senator Landis is correct in saying that most of the things that are involved with this bill are...deal mostly with women and women issues, which is...puts Senator Chambers in a rather strange position of advocating for minorities and advocating for women while, at the same time, trying to not have this bill be too restrictive. I would like to comment on the Asian population who have come to this country and have used this as an entrepreneurial avenue for making the American dream. If you make money in this country, you have to file income tax and it has to be in English. If you sell a product, you have to have sales tax and that has to be...all the applications and the requirements need to be done in English. If you lease space in a...in some kind of a building for this activity, you have to sign a lease that's in English. Pretty much, to get along in this country, you have to know English. I don't know whether having to take an English exam, there are probably over 200 professional exams that have to be taken and all of them are in English in this state. I would agree to a bracket clause and a bracket motion and work on this with Senator Chambers and try to get something more reasonable. The Cosmetology Board is the one that set the hours at 600 hours. And a letter that Senator Chambers sent around wanting us to look at the 600 hours, he highlighted one paragraph, but the paragraph below it says don't...from this school director, don't get me wrong, 600 hours is a wonderful amount of time, if the school has time to fulfill the state's requirements. So it's not that she's having trouble with the 600 hours. She likes the 600 hours. I think there's more to nail tech than Senator Chambers realizes. It is a complicated procedure. Even though he thinks it's frivolous and silly, it isn't when you see the kind of infections and problems that can be caused with some of this procedure. And I do ask the body to not return it to Select File to strike the enacting clause, but I would agree to a bracket. Thank you, Mr. President.
