PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: No need. No other lights on, Senator. Thank you, though. Chair recognizes Senator Wehrbein to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I'll be very brief. I think this does make the case that this is what we created NITC for. I believe, in this case, it should fall back under that. That's what this amendment does, brings it...restores the exclusion that's in the bill and says that it will be viewed by...overviewed by the NITC. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The question before us is the adoption of Amendment 515 to LB 446. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?
