PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Janssen, would you yield.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Certainly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Janssen, and this is not a frivolous thing I am going to bring up, the head coach of the men's basketball program at UNL, the head coach of the women's basketball coach...program at UNL, the head coach of the football team at UNL, and the UNL Athletic Director are people who can get very deeply involved in large sums of money from sources outside of the state, outside of the university system, totally divorced from government. Senator Janssen, I know, for a fact, that in other states, these people have to file financial statements declaring the source and the amounts of their outside income. I don't know if they're required to state a certain company or individual by name, but would you be opposed to an amendment that would require these individuals holding the positions I outlined to file one of these statements? That's the question I am asking you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Chambers, I was visiting with Senator Schimek. Would you run those by me again, those positions that you were talking about?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, the head coach of the men's...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...basketball program at UNL, of the women's basketball program at UNL, the football team at UNL, and the Athletic Director.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, Senator Chambers, I am not exactly sure on how that they...they have to file these. I think they do have to explain somewhere along the line where they're getting extra money other than their professional job. That's my assumption. I don't...you probably know a little better than that, but I'm assuming that there is somewhere that they have to disclose what their extra salaries are over and above the ones that the university is paying.
